She had been a Boy Scout leader, Children's Church Director for over twenty years and a fundraising guru for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Sharon and Al started hosting trail rides in the surrounding areas to help raise money for St. Jude and over the years have raised over \$40,000! She owned and operated Heart's Desire Antiques and Collectables in White Deer and probably used it as more of a platform for her ministry than to make sales. She would absolutely stop whatever she may be doing to pray for anyone, anywhere at any time. She was the epitome of a Christian in that she was always prepared to share her testimony, pray, listen, teach, or just love unconditionally as Christ does. Although Sharon was not tech savvy by any means, she was devoted to sharing a scripture to a group of about 50 individuals every morning using social media and her Facebook page. Living her life for Christ and spreading God's Word was of the utmost importance in her life, but her family and love for children followed closely behind. She and Al had been foreign exchange student hosts for years, paving another avenue for them to share Christ with 10 students that passed through their home from all around the world. At times, when one would least expect it, Sharon would release a bit of her sly humor, then in keeping with her innocence, act as if she didn't realize how shaded it really was.

Sharon's unconditional love, devotion, compassion, discipline, and determination to spread salvation and love have touched imaginable people from all walks of life and will be missed by so many.

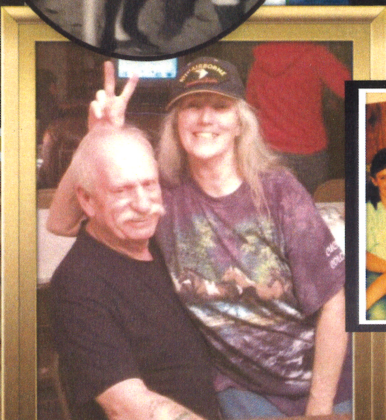
