for HIS NAME's sake.

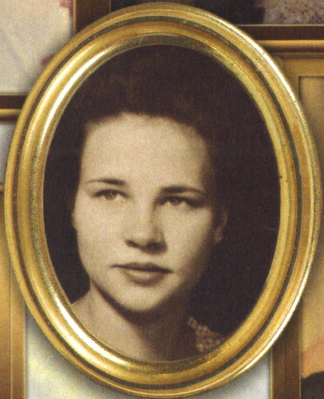
Yea, though I walk through the valley
