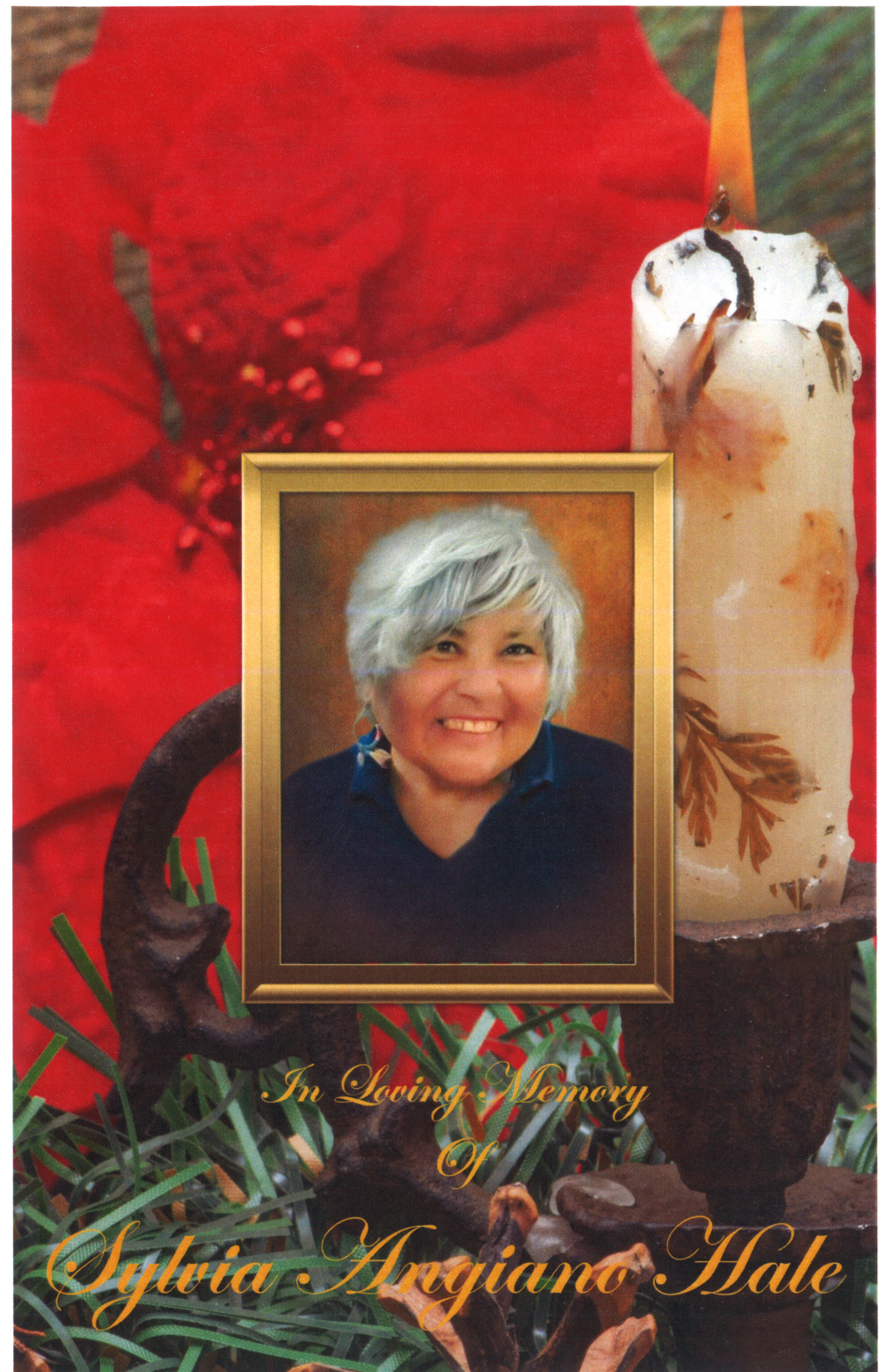

# Footprints

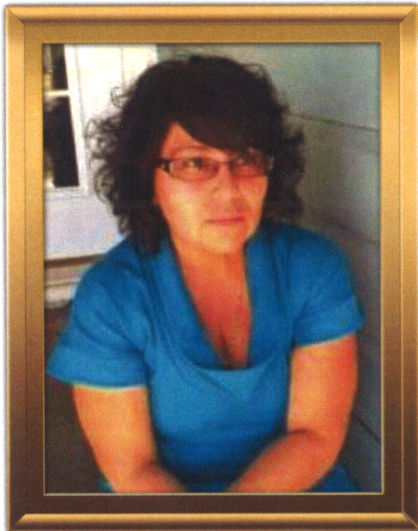
## One night I had a dream.
