Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, please remember social distancing and although masks are not required, they are strongly preferred.

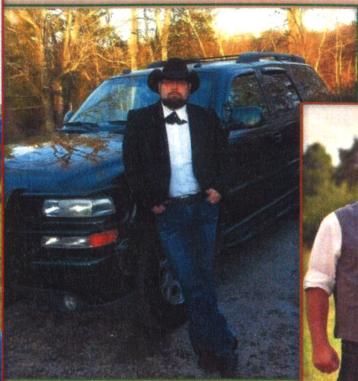
