She was born the oldest of four children to Walter and Joeldine Elliott on July 24, 1936, in Kellerville, Texas.

Beginning at an early age, Feleise had a compassionate and nurturing heart that indeed played a major role in her becoming a CNA and working in the nursing and healthcare industry caring for others. All of these traits are contributing factors to a long and successful marriage of 57 years to Bobby. Although a resident of a nursing home, she remained continually active until her passing. Once again, the ability to care for others fulfilled her heart as she was able to call bingo and assist with other resident's needs. Feleise's warm smile, hearty laughter and tender care will be missed by so many whose lives she has touched.
