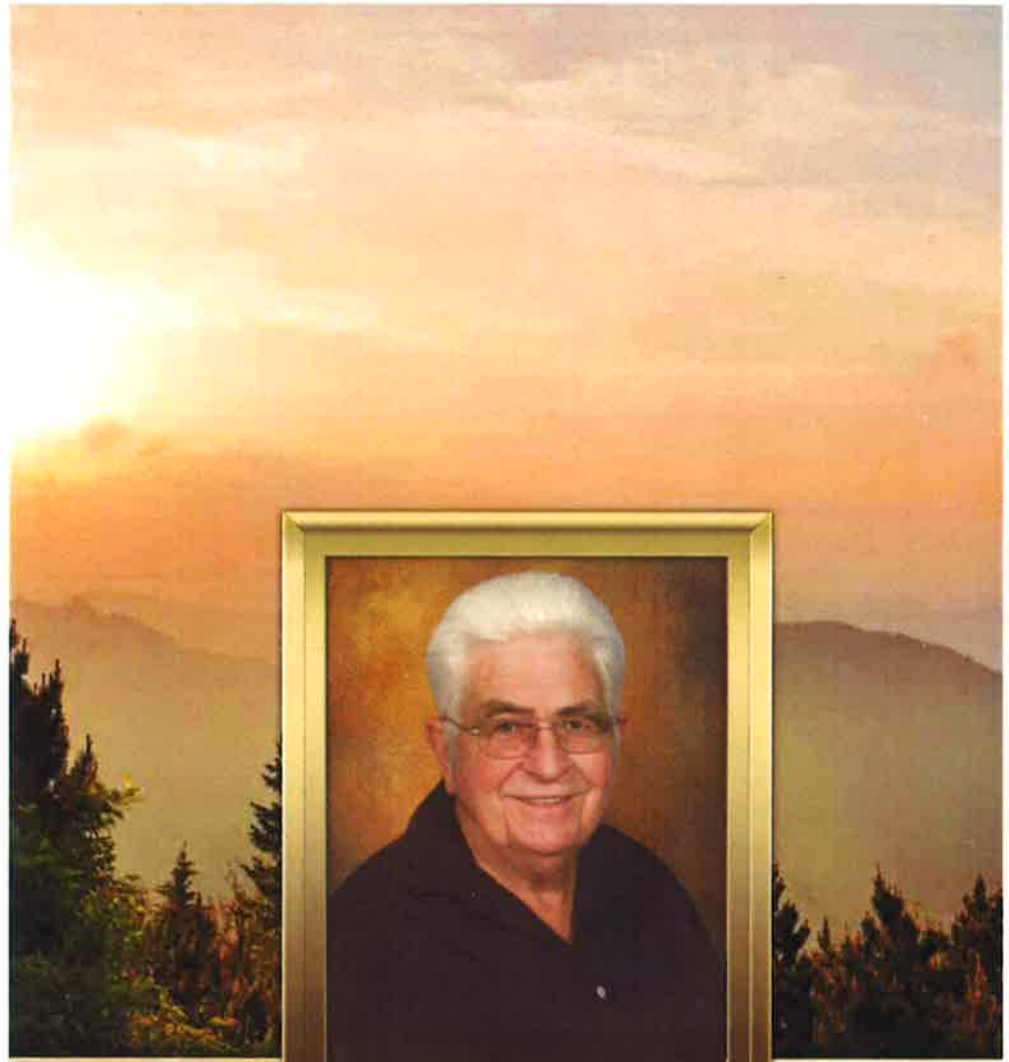
Those who preceded him in death were his parents and a sister, Lou Stevens.
