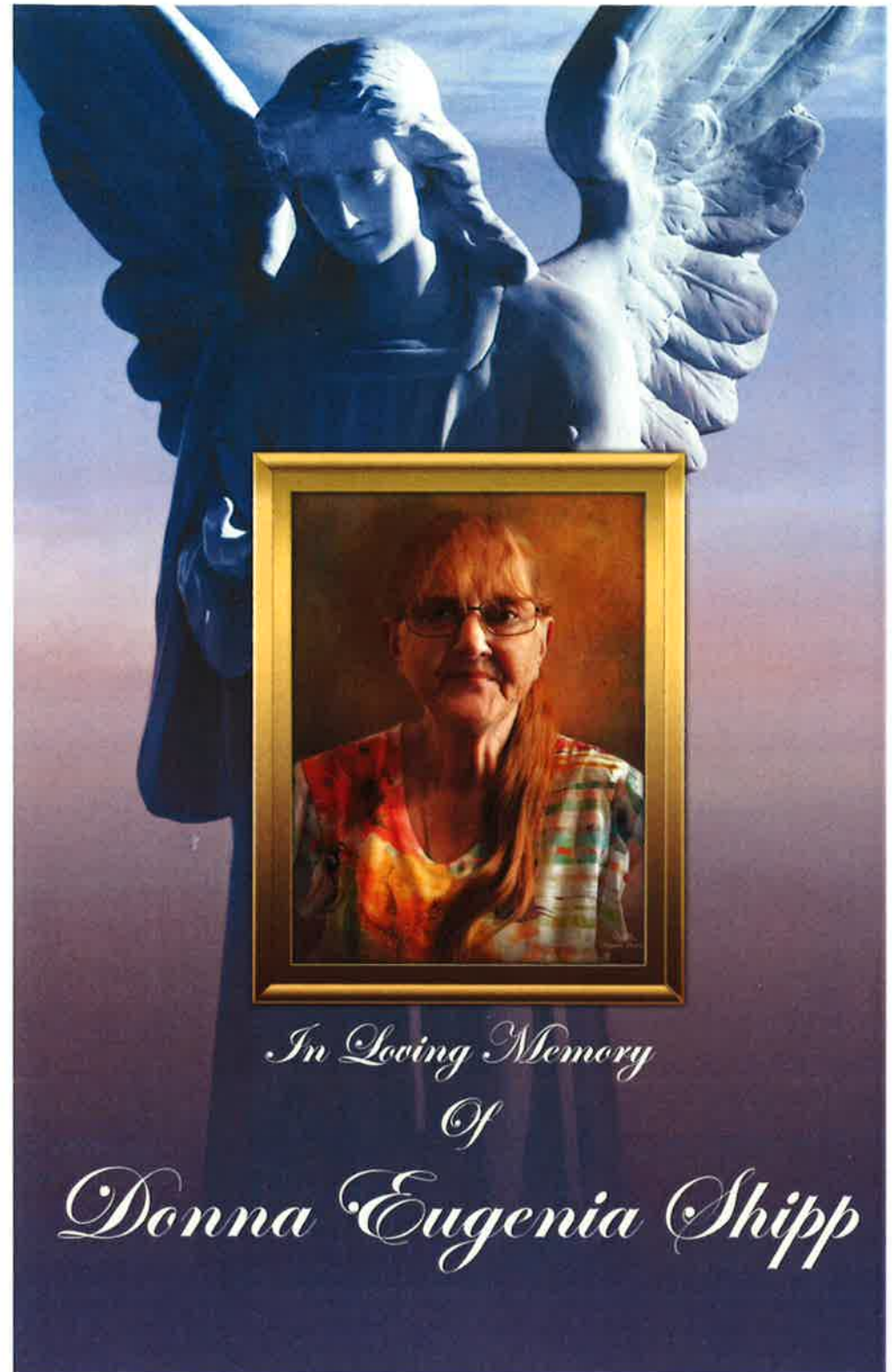
Those who went on before her were her parents, a son, Michael Eugene McCain and her significant companion, Gene Gee.

While thinking of the many things we didn't get to say.

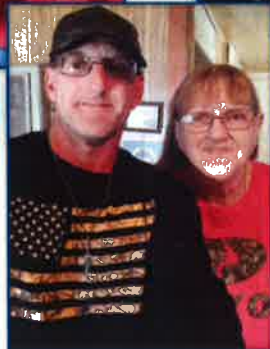
I know how much you love me as much as I love you;
