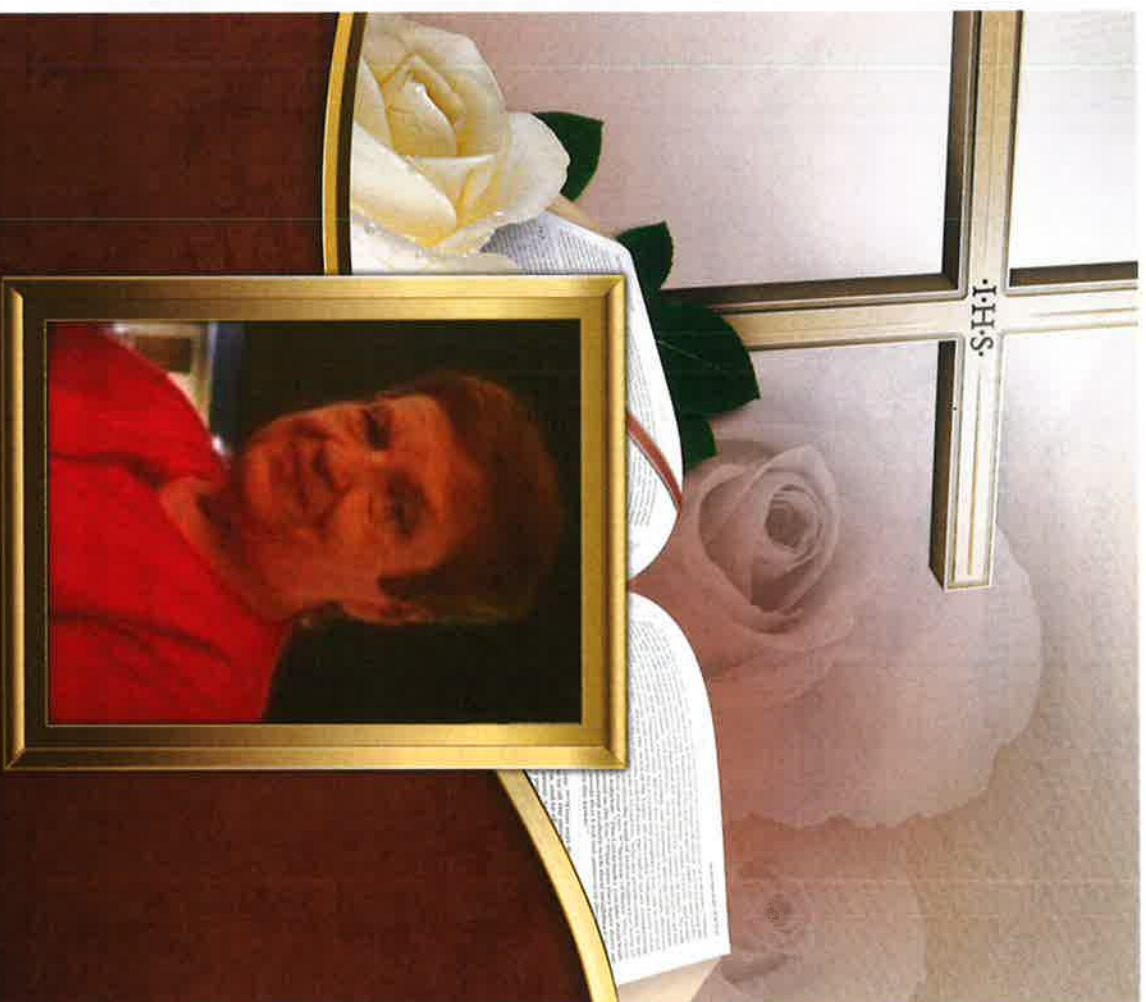
Meeting her on the road to heaven were her parents, and brothers, Phillip and John Ashton.
