When not on one of his wild adventures, Mark was relatively quiet, yet somewhat of a prankster – at least to his siblings. He will be missed by all who knew and loved him.

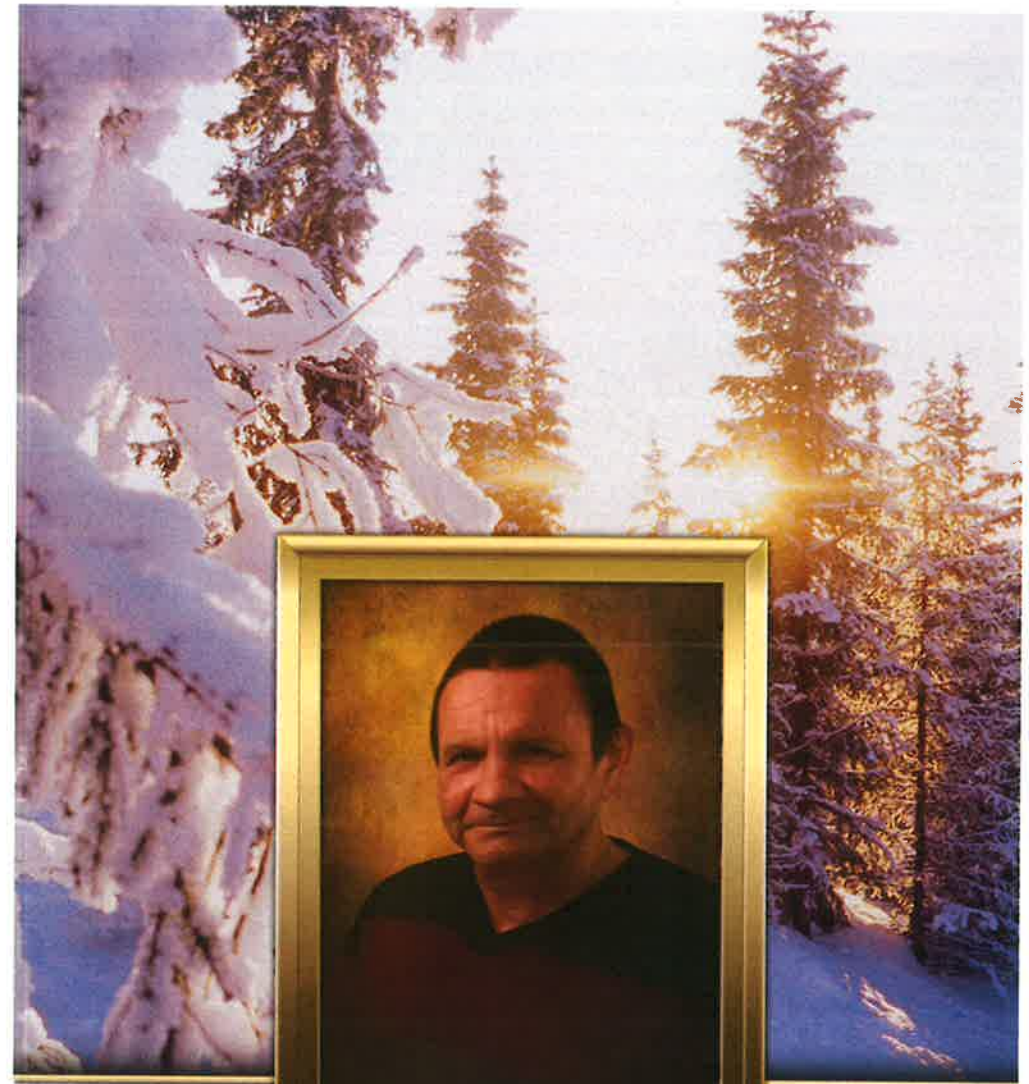
He was greeted into Heaven by his parents, Lee Miller and Doris Jean Puckett.
