

During the pandemic, for two years, JoAnn livestreamed herself...well, only her hands, playing hymns, and ministering to others through her music. She was also very artistic and a talented painter, her house is full of her paintings and only the good Lord knows how many of her painted items she has blessed others with. She loved to play games; trash talked and cheated (but only in a sincere Christian manner) to win! JoAnn was extremely stubborn and strong willed, she had a great sense of humor and never ran short on wit and somehow, she was very demanding, yet in a sweet and loving way. She deemed herself Queen of her birthdays and her favorite phrase was "Because JoAnn said so!" Certainly, one of a kind, her spunk, her humor, and love will be missed by all who knew her.
